

# Stage 2 Jigsaw Reading Tasks




# About Your Holiday.

#### Languages

Generally the predominant language used on the holiday will be that of the host country, but in the majority of cases the group will be of mixed nationality. English is often understood but you will gain more from your holiday with the knowledge of some basic phrases in the language concerned. The International Conversation Book, supplied to you free, details many words and phrases that you will find useful and covers ten different languages. In the case of holidays involving instruction, this will be given in the local language (except in Scandinavia and possibly in Holland) and you need a working knowledge of the language of the host
