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## 1 In-class exercises

- For each sentence, define the two interpretations. Mark constituents with square brackets to indicate the different structures and the interpretation they give rise to.
(1) a. Peter saw [ the boy [ with the binoculars ] ]. the boy had the binoculars
b. Peter [ saw [ the boy ] [ with the binoculars ] ]. Peter had the binoculars
(2) a. Mary saw tall [ [ tall boys ] and girls ]. only the boys were tall
b. Mary saw [ tall [ boys and girls ] ]. all children were tall
(3) a. Mary saw [ boys and [ girls [ who are tall ] ] ]. only the girls were tall
b. Mary saw [ [ boys and girls ] [ who are tall ] ]. all children were tall
(4) a. [ John said [ on Friday ] [he would come over ] ]. said on Monday
b. John said [ [ on Friday ] he would come over ]. came over on Monday

d. $\quad \mathrm{DP} \rightarrow \mathrm{D} \mathrm{N}$
the ball
a bag
